Summary Annual Report for UA Local 190 Plumbers/Pipefitters/Service Technicians/Gas Distribution Defined Contribution Plan

This is a summary of the annual report for UA Local 190 Plumbers/Pipefitters/Service Technicians/Gas Distribution Defined Contribution Plan, EIN 38-3316535, Plan Number 002, for period June 1, 2006 to May 31, 2007.

The annual report has been filed with the Pension and Welfare Benefits Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the plan are provided by a trust. Plan expenses were \$734,974. These expenses included benefit payments of \$638,161, administrative expenses of \$96,813 and \$0 in other expenses. A total of 1,270 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

Plan assets, after subtracting liabilities totaled \$13,777,507 as of May 31, 2007 compared to \$11,018,480 as of June 1, 2006. During the year the plan experienced a change in its net assets of \$2,759,027. This change includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$3,500,721, which included employer contributions of \$305,964, employee contributions of \$1,578,120, realized gains of \$0 from the sale of assets, and \$1,616,637 in net earnings from investments.

Minimum Funding Standards

Enough money was contributed to the plan to keep it funded in accordance with the minimum funding standards of ERISA.
